

Mixed Social Intermediate

This will consist of three pools 1A, 1B and 1C with six teams in each pool. These pools are seeded based on last years results, basically it is quite similar to the way the world cup groups are selected.

Week 1-4: Pool Matches, each team will play each other team in their pool

Week 5: *Fancy Dress Night and Friendly matches*

Week 6: Final game of the Pool Matches

At the completion of these pool matches teams are re-graded in to a further three groups of six. This would be graded as the Top 2 teams in 1A, 1B and 1C go in to Group 1 Premier League, 3rd and 4th Ranked teams go in to Group 1 Championship, 5th and 6th Ranked teams go in to Group 1 Intermediate League.

Week 7-10: Divisional Matches, each team play each other team in their League/Championship/Intermediate League (except the team they have already played in the pool matches stage i.e. week 1-6)

Week 11: FINALS

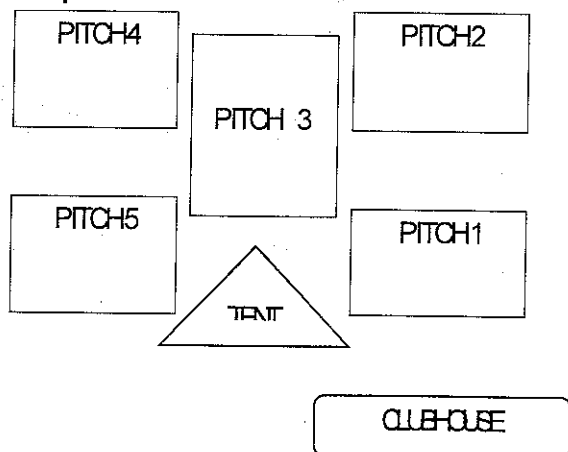
LAWS TO REMEMBER

**Girls tries are worth 3 points no matter if there are more than 3 girls on the pitch.

**Golden try in playoff games.

Things to remember on Game Day!!

- Arrive 20 min before kick-off.
- Each game is **7 a side** and you must have **3 girls** on the pitch at all times
- You can only have a **panel of 15** on game night.
- All players must be **over 18**.
- In order to play in the Finals you must have played in 3 games
- Match Times will be **6.30, 7.15, 8.00 and 8.45**
